• How long does the BTK WINTER COURSES run for?

Our Winter courses are 2 classes a week for 11 weeks. It starts Monday, January 18 through Friday, March 26

Do all students have to take all courses?

No, the students can choose the courses they want to take.

Are family discounts available?

Yes, if you choose to register your second child, we are providing a 5% discount. A 10% discount is provided for each additional child beyond two.

Are refunds available?

Refunds are not available. All registrations are final as class sizes are limited.

• Are scholarship opportunities available?

Unfortunately, we do not have scholarships available at this moment.

In what time zone is the BTK program being held?

We will run the BTK program: Monday & Wednesday 5:00-5:45 PM EST / 2:00-2:45 PM PST Thursday & Friday 4:30-5:15 PM EST / 1:30-2:15 PM PST

What shoes are needed for classes?

We understand that everyone's dance environment is different at the moment – some may be dancing on carpet, some may have slick wooden floors, etc. We place an emphasis on safety and recommend you assess what is the best for your child's dance experience in the home environment, whether that be dancing in bare feet, jazz shoes, socks (on carpet), etc.
