

RULES & REGULATIONS

Failure to comply with World Dance Movement rules could result in disqualification from the aerial competition. These rules differ from other traditional competition rules, so please read carefully.

COMPETITION RULES

- 1) This competition is open to aerial dance students and emerging aerial dance groups.
- 2) Students and dancers 7 years old and up are accepted.
- 3) Participants can compete in the following age groups:

Student: 7-11 years old/Junior: 12-16 years old / Senior: 17-39 years old / 40+ : 40 years + /Pre-Pro: 14+

4) FEES:

5) Participants can compete in the following categories:

DanceCompGenie website registration fee: one-time \$4.75 fee per dancer per event.

- 1. Aerial Silk Soloist/Duo
- 2. Aerial Hoop Soloist/Duo
- 3. Unconventional Aerial Apparatus [Trapeze / Pole / Lyra / Sling (hammock) / rope / cloud swing / net / cube / sphere / ladder and umbrella. Aerialist must supply their own apparatus for this category. Soloist/Duo

The following elements are allowed: Tricks, Dynamic, work on Silk or Hoop and spins.

- 6) The WDM International Competition will be held on **July 9 & 10**, **2026 Schedule to be determined closer to the dates**
- 7) In order to participate in the competition, every school must fill out the online registration forms and full payment no later than **June 18, 2026**

8) Choreography cannot exceed: 8A) To exceed minutes there will be a \$10/10€ charge

2:30 minutes for Soloist 3:00 minutes for Duo

- per minute: ex. 3:01to 4:00 = \$10/10 € etc
- 9) All music must be uploaded on your registration at: worlddancemovement.dancecompgenie.com If we do not have your music, you will be disqualified with no refund of entry fee.
- 10) Any props used for the choreography must be easy to remove from the stage.
- 11) REHEARSAL ON STAGE: On the basis of the number of participants, rehearsals on stage will be arranged and scheduled before the competition.

12) STAGE INFORMATION:

INFORMATION ABOUT SUSPENSION POINTS: a supporting beam (10 meters long and 7 meters high) with n. 3 static points. (no motor/winch or pulley)

WDM will provide 3 tissues: 2 white and 1 blue, length: 8 meters, certified Unicycle. SIZE OF THE STAGE: 10,30 meters / depth, 13,30 meters / width, 1,10 meters / height

Access from stairs: upstage left and upstage right. The rigging point is equipped with an adjustable pulley system. During rehearsal, the desired height is set in collaboration with the rigger. For aerial hoops, the crew provides 2-meter-long endless round slings (SPANSETS).

13) From ages 7 to age 15, the use of a mattress IS COMPULSORY.

From age 16+, this is OPTIONAL.

- 14) Swinging towards any direction with the aerial silks/hoop IS NOT ALLOWED.
- 15) We will have basic lights for everyone. As the event is outdoors, the earlier entries will perform in natural sunlight. The stage is covered. A lighting and sound technician will be present.
- 16) We decline any responsibilities for damage to people or objects that may occur during the competition and rehearsal.
- 17) Registration fees are not refundable. No exceptions.
- 18) The organizers of the competition can cancel a section of the competition or the entire competition, if there are not enough participants pre-registered. Only in that case will the registration fees will be refunded.
- 19) The organizers can combine styles and categories within an age group if there are not at least 5 entries in a specific style or category. (I.E. If there are only 3 student duos in Aerial Silk and 2 student trios in Aerial Hoop, they can be combined and compete against each other if and only if they are the same age group).
- 20) Judges' decisions are final and can't be objected.
- 21) During the competition video recording and pictures have to be authorized by the organizers.

ADJUDICATION

World Dance Movement judges are a combination of; Internationally acclaimed teachers, company directors, choreographers and currently performing dance professionals. World Dance Movement judges are well trained in multiple genres of dance and are sensitive to the various skill levels represented by the dancers' differing ages.

Performances will be judged based on the following criteria and point system.

Costume – Appropriateness, in line with the choice of music 5 points

Choreography – Originality, in line with the choice of music 10 points

Showmanship – performance quality and stage presence 20 points

Difficulty – Quality in the execution of tricky drops. 20 points

Technique – fundamental knowledge/figures correct execution 25 points

Flexibility – Shoulders, back and legs flexibility 20 points

The average score from all judges will remain the performer's final score. The Technique score in all final top four placements will break any and all ties.

We will combine categories if there are less than 5 entries in any category (solo/duo and style (silk/hoop/Unconventional Aerial Apparatus). We will never combine age groups.
